The challenge for IFS customers



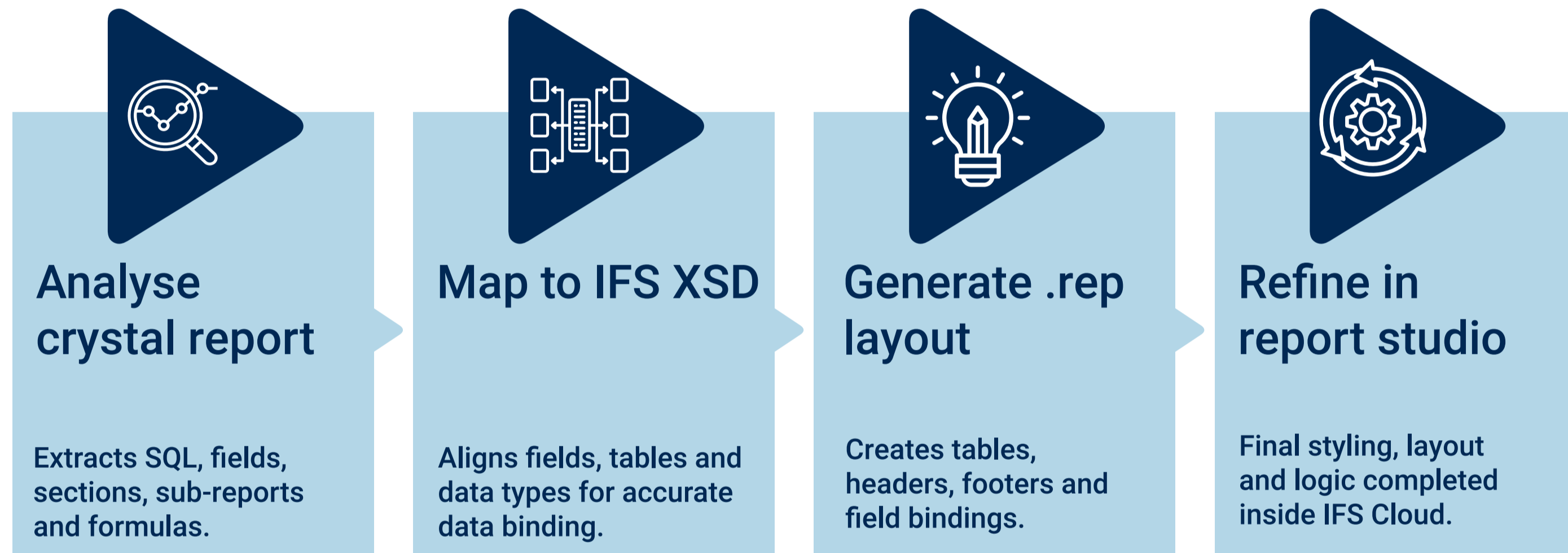
- Many organisations have large and complex reporting estates.

- Reduced effort and pressure on internal teams.

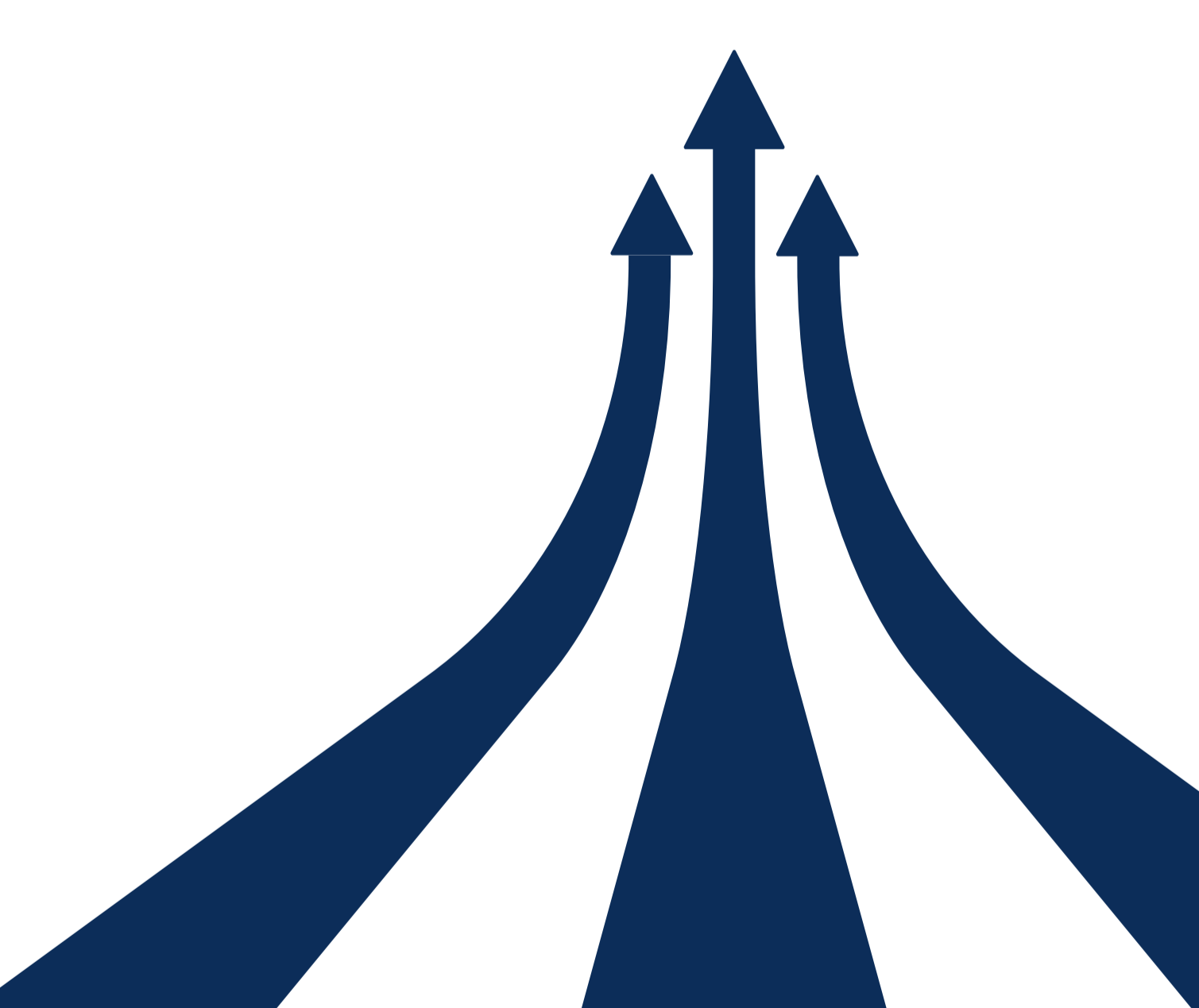
