

IFS AP invoicing vs Platned ParsaAI

IFS AI-powered AP invoicing

Purpose built to automate accounts payable workflows within the IFS ERP environment.

Key capabilities include:

- Uses AI and machine learning to read, classify and validate invoices.
- Matches invoices to purchase orders and contracts.
- Automates approval routing based on business rules.
- Integrates with IFS modules such as BOLO, Excalibur and Qbyte.
- Provides compliance, auditability and control within the IFS platform.

Primary focus:

Invoice capture, matching and workflow automation inside IFS.

Platned ParsaAI

An AI-driven finance assistant designed to enhance financial analysis, reporting and decision support across connected systems.

Key capabilities include:

- Automated invoice intake directly from email and digital channels.
- Automatic invoice creation at the point of receipt.
- Connects to ERP, accounting systems, planning platforms and data warehouses.
- Provides natural language queries.
- Provides automated analysis insights.

Primary focus:

Invoice automation and AI-enabled access to finance data across multiple systems.

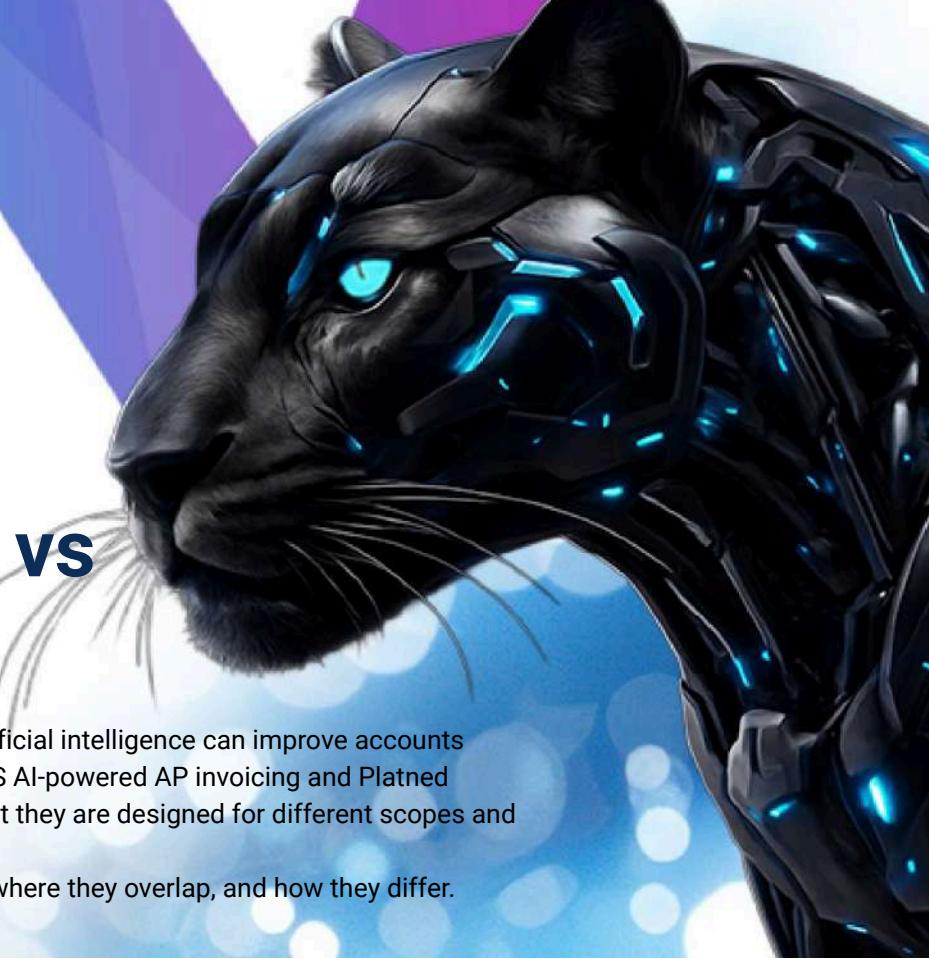
Shared capabilities
